


some options to be presented to the Board for approval.





LYSA Membership Meeting Call to Order: A meeting of the LYSA Membership and Board was held on March 14, 2023 at the home of Craig and Megan Anderson on Olive Avenue in Merced. The meeting convened at 7:00 pm.

**Reports - Actions - Discussions: Commodore, Thom Gri-maldi:** Welcomed members to the meeting. Invited Board Members to report.


