LYSA General Meeting Minutes prepared by Debbie Harden

Thom Grimaldi called the meeting to order at 7:00 pm.

He thanked members who raced and attended the Regatta.

Thom announced the upcoming Open House and asked that people step up to help out with it.

Thom asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the May meeting as written in the LightAir. Craig Anderson motioned, Debbie Harden was the second, all approved.

Dan Aleman announced that we have LYSA caps available in 3 colors, \$25. He passed around two t-shirt samples for the material approval. Matt suggested that Dan might want to talk to Kendall because he had done a lot of research about t-shirts in the past.

Lee gave kudos to those who have helped with the dock work. More work needed, but progress is being made.

Tammy talked about the wine & cheese event that was held and how successful it was. The next one will be on July 28th, 6-9pm, BYOB & an appetizer to share.

The Club will provide a cheese/fruit plate. Craig suggested that the event advertisement be sent out to members more often leading up to the event.

Tom Cooke was pleased with the Regatta. Thanked all the helpers. Thursday night races are going well. He announced that there will be no races on June 29th and July 6. He reminded people that when the races are being called (beginning & end) to keep their voices down when out on the docks, so that the Race Committee can focus & hear each other.

John Derby asked whether we wanted advertisement in the Merced County Times. The general consensus was no advertisement on the wine & cheese event, but yes on Thursday races, Junior Sail & other Club functions as approved.
