

When you go to the website you will see a heading that says Club. Click on it and a dropdown menu appears. One of the options on the menu is Reservations. If you click on Reservations, it takes you to our calendar and the necessary form. If you have trouble with that, contact me and I will email you the form. It must be completed, signed, and returned before your event.

There is an agreement with the form that needs to be followed. The agreement can be read on the reservation page of our website. I have posted it below. Two rather important rules have been violated this season (two that I am aware of) and I want to make sure all members (new and not so new) are clear about the expectations of the Club. To reserve the Clubhouse, you must agree to the following terms and conditions:

- I am a current LYSA member in good standing.
- I will leave the house and grounds clean and in proper order.
- If the House Captain or Board determine the house or yard is not left in proper order and cleanliness, I agree to pay a cleaning fee.
   Amount determined by the Board based on condition.

- A LYSA member will be present at all times when guests are on the premises.
- I will procure the necessary permits for the event if required (amplified music, overnight camping, etc.)
