

LYSA Membership Meeting Call to Order: A meeting of the LYSA Membership and Board was held on September 12, 2023 at the LYSA Clubhouse. The meeting convened at 7:08 pm.

Reports - Actions - Discussions: Commodore, Thom Grimaldi: Welcomed members to the meeting. Invited Board Members to report.

Approval of Minutes: Minutes are published in the Newsletter, Members can read and review the minutes in advance of the meeting. Corrections: None.

Chris informed Members present that she has a meeting scheduled for October 12, and will not be able to attend the LYSA meeting scheduled for that evening. She requested a substitute note-taker.

Motion: Moved by Tami to approve minutes by acclimation, second by Tom. Motion carried. Minutes approved by acclimation.

Commodore, Thom Grimaldi: Shrimp Feed planning / logistics discussed. Donation of rigatoni. Wine \$160/ \$600. Servers. Bridget & Joel run kitchen. Thom picking up shrimp Friday morning / afternoon from the supplier, coming on a truck to the Italo. Jerry asked that the shrimp be defrosted in advance, Jerry and Tom will take care of it. Jay: it is very time consuming to break all the shrimp apart. Yard, gate. Ticket sales going well. Thom ordered another table of 10. 5 of 10, the rest are 8. Will use glass tables for Auction. Deb shared she ordered two Costco cakes and will pick them up on Friday.

Vice Commodore, Dan Aleman: Shirts are ready. Diane will write check and will take it to Image Masters. He will hang on rack, will label small, medium, large. Discussed burgees, will hang on display. Dan and Peg will meet on Friday and will sort out Raffle items. Dan will handle dessert auction. Discussed 12 desserts, Tami suggested 12 bags with forks, napkins, plates, etc. to be given to each item winner so they can share with their table.

Treasurer, Diane Sousa: Reviewed Treasurer's Report. 75 Members, 44 slips rented. Incentive to be involved with Shrimp Feed, it's a great investment in the Club.

Dock Captain, Lee McDonough: Deb shared Lee's report. Water level will fluctuate a lot during September. Be aware and check dock lines so your boat isn't smashed under the docks. We will probably have water through October. Thom: the finger is built and partially attached.

House Captain, Deb Harden: Winter Storage: 11 spots available. Deb requested that boats are maintained and properly tagged. Discussed: Dock Captain responsibility

to ensure their vessels are properly tagged, the Parks & Rec staff don't have the time to tag boats an don't want to hand Members a tag. They want to place the tags directly on the boats themselves.

Cruise / Social Committee, Tami Davidson: Tami presented our next event: Friday, October 27, 6 to 9. Octoberfest with End of Season Party, Awards and Elections. Catered by Strings. Tami will put something together for Friday, November 17th, 5 to 9 or Saturday the 18th, 2 to 6 pm. Thom: Christmas Ball at the Italo in December.


John & Kathy Laing. *Motion*: Moved by Tom, second by Tami. *Motion carried*. Diane will call and let them know.


Discussion items:
